- 3. Why do you think it was important for Patou to work hard to make his hurt leg better?
- 4. What do you think would have happened if he had not worked to get his leg better?
- 5. Why do you think Niki sat by Patou's side when he was doing his leg exercises every day?
- 6. Do you ever feel stubborn when someone asks you to do something you don't want to do? Give an example.
- 7. When they play games, why do you think Niki sometimes lets Patou win?
- 8. What are some of the reasons Patou has for deciding his life is not so hard after all?
- 9. If you could say one thing to Patou, what would you say?
- 10. Do you have any questions after reading this book?



- 1. Can you draw a picture or make a card for Patou that expresses how you feel about him after reading this book?
- 2. Do you have a pet(s) that you are proud of? If so, draw a card for each of your favorite pet(s) telling them how you feel.
- 3. Are there times when you are proud of yourself for learning something new? Can you draw a picture that shows one or more of the many things you are proud of learning?
